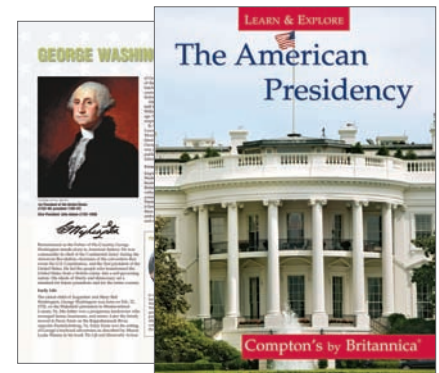


### THE AMERICAN PRESIDENCY
